In 2006, The Endowment Fund became separately incorporated in order to support the operation and maintenance of the VCRC and help further the mission of the JLBR, Inc.

The Funding Resource Library housed in the VCRC is a Foundation Center Cooperating Collection (CC). This highly prestigious approval was granted based on an application that was submitted to The Foundation Center. The JLBR Funding Resource Library joins the other approximately 240 Cooperating Collections in the United States.

As a CC, the JLBR Funding Resource Library is available to grant-seekers at no cost, and provides access to The Foundation Directory On-line, the leading grant-seeking database on the web, along with a core collection of Foundation Center directories and publications.

In addition to the library programming is also available at the VCRC. Educational sessions for the public, including classes on the basics of grant-seeking, dialogues with local donors, and serves as host for The Foundation Center's fee based, full-day grant-seeker training courses.
